SKYTRANS DELIVER EXPANDED SERVICE

INCREASED FLIGHTS TO NORTHERN PENINSULA AREA

The regional airline Skytrans commenced a new service on 18th May 2009 from Cairns to Northern Peninsula Area (Bamaga); initially offering three return flights a week with a promise to increase this number to five over time.

"I'm pleased to announce that effective 23rd June we will introduce Tuesday flights direct from Cairns to Northern Peninsula Area. We are able to make this announcement only 5 weeks after our inaugural flight courtesy of the enormous response we have had from our customers" said Skytrans Chief Executive Officer, Simon Wild.

With this additional link Skytrans now services the Northern Peninsula area weekly on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Fares start from a low \$270 one way, available online all day everyday.

Over the coming months Skytrans will monitor load capacity with the objective to add a 5th service in response to community needs.

Skytrans flights to the Northern Peninsula Area depart from the Cairns Domestic Terminal and form part of a growing network of 25 destinations serviced by Skytrans throughout regional Queensland.
